Ron Miles will work that job and receive his street department hourly rate for that day. The Borough Secretary will send a letter to the resident.

Council reported that the owner of the collapsing wall, Mr. Meyers, was fined \$100.00 at the Magistrate Hearing on August 2, 2006. The fine would go up to \$300.00 if no action is taken to repair the wall.

Blake McCandless stated that the owner of 15 North Avenue has begun painting the front.

Sandra Phillips stated that the back of the house needs to be repaired as well.

Council noted that the Planning Commission meeting scheduled for August 9, 2006, has been rescheduled for Wednesday, August 16, 2006, at 7:00 p.m. The change was advertised.
