§ 82-1. Authorization of coverage for employees.

§ 82-1. Authorization of coverage for employees.

- A. The Borough Council hereby authorizes the proper officers of said Borough to execute and deliver to the said State Agency a plan and agreement required under Section 6 of the said Enabling Act (Act No. 491)¹ and the Social Security Act whereby social security coverage may be extended to employees of East Washington Borough, and the said proper Borough officers are empowered to do all necessary acts and things to properly establish said coverage for the employees of said Borough.
- B. The Borough Secretary is hereby authorized to establish a system of payroll deductions to be matched by payments by the said Borough to be made into the contribution fund of the Social Security Act through the office of the State Agency and to make charges of this tax to the fund from which wage or salary payments are issued to employees of the Borough. Such payments are to be made in accordance with the provisions of the law and the regulations promulgated by the State Agency and the Federal Security Administrator. Such payments as are delinquent shall bear interest as required by state and federal law.
- C. Appropriation is hereby made from the proper fund, or funds, of the Borough of the necessary money required by the contribution fund, as provided in Section 4 of the Enabling Act, and in accordance with the plan and agreement. Authority is given the proper Borough officers to enter into an agreement with the State Agency in accordance with paragraph 218 of the Social Security Act. Such plan and agreement shall provide that the participation of East Washington Borough in said plan shall commence October 1, 1953.
