§ 181-1. Prohibition.

No person shall, except in necessary defense of person or property, fire or discharge any gun or other firearm, or any air gun or spring gun or other implement or instrument which discharges or propels with force any metal slug, pellet or ball of any kind, at any place within the Borough of East Washington.

§ 181-2. Violations and penalties. [Amended 11-7-2005 by Ord. No. 481]

Any person, firm or corporation which shall violate any provision of this chapter shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$600 and/or to imprisonment for a term not to exceed 90 days.
