§ 53-1. Establishment of the East Washington Planning Commission.

There is hereby established a planning commission to be known as the "East Washington Planning Commission."

§ 53-2. Appointment of the members of the East Washington Planning Commission.

- A. The East Washington Planning Commission shall consist of five residents of the Borough appointed by the Council of the Borough of East Washington, at least three of whom shall not hold any other appointive or elective position within the government of the Borough of East Washington.
- B. Two of the members shall be initially appointed for the terms of four years each. Two of the members shall be initially appointed for the terms of three years each. One of the members shall be initially appointed for a term of two years.
- C. On expiration of the term of a member, a successor shall be appointed for a term of four years. Vacancies occurring for reasons other than expiration of term shall be filled by the Council for the unexpired term.
- D. Commission members shall serve without compensation and may be reimbursed for expenses.

§ 53-3. Powers and duties of the East Washington Planning Commission.

The East Washington Planning Commission shall carry forth all duties and have all powers as fully set forth in the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code, being the Act of July 31,

1968, P.L. 805, No. 247, as amended, and shall have such other powers and duties as the Council of the Borough of East Washington shall from time to time ordain.
